- 3.) Write a book review in MLA format as a 5-paragraph essay that is at least 2 pages & uses complex, compound sentences:
 - a.) Introduction
 - b.) Body Paragraph 1 - Summary of the Book
 - c.) Body Paragraph 2 - Characterization (Examples of Direct and Indirect - S.T.E.A.L.)
 - d.) Body Paragraph 3 - Your Opinion/Review
 - e.) Conclusion
- 4.) Print, staple, and turn in the essay and sequence of seven by Friday, November 30, 2018

MLA Format:

- 1.) Heading: name, teacher's name, class & period, date
- 2.) Title: centered with each word capitalized
- 3.) Header: last name and inserted page number
- 4.) Entire Paper: double- spaced, 12 pt. font, and consistent font
- 5.) Each Paragraph: indented with no extra spaces

This is an example of how to correctly format in **MLA (Modern Language Association) style.**

Heading:
- Student's Name
- Teacher's Name
- Class & Period
- Date (Day, Month, Year)

Title: Centered with each word capitalized (with the exception of small words like of, a, etc. unless they're the first or last word).

Header: Student's last name and insert page number (do not just write 1 or it will appear on every page). This should be aligned to the right and half an inch from the top.

My Agreements: Being the Best You (THIS IS AN EXAMPLE ONLY)

Entire Paper: Double spaced and 12 pt. font. Should be Times New Roman, Arial, or Calibri. Margins are normal which is an inch from the edge.

Each Paragraph: Indented with a tab which is a half of an inch. There are no extra spaces between paragraphs
