LEARNING, LIVING, & LEAVING LIFELONG LESSONS

You will create a graphic novel that teaches a lesson that you learned from TATDOAPTI. You will read it and gift it to a 6th grade student at New West when it is complete.

PROJECT: The graphic novel should showcase your ability to tell a story through this medium and prove your commitment to storytelling. Your skills will be displayed as you stay true to the lesson learned, tell a creative/original story, and remain specific to your audience.

As of last week, you should have selected 3 lessons from TATDOAPTI and created 3 corresponding summaries of original stories that you could use to teach that same lesson. Over this past weekend, you should have selected one of those stories and constructed a sequence of seven (story structure) for one of those original stories. The next step for your graphic novel will be to storyboard the content for each page so that you have an outline and understanding before you begin to draft your story.

SEQUENCE OF SEVEN:

Write down your sequence of seven here so that you have it in the same space as your storyboard.

1.) Exposition (introduction): [content pages 1-2*]

2.) Inciting Incident (begins major conflict): [content page 3*]

3.) Rising Action (events leading to climax): [content pages 4-6*]

4.) Climax (the turning point): [content page 7*]

5.) Falling Action (events leading to resolution): [content page 8*]

6.) Resolution (solves/closure of major conflict): [content page 9*]

7.) Dénouement (ties up rest of story): [content pages 10-11*]

*the pages given are to help guide your content but are not mandatory if your story needs adjustment

STORYBOARD:

In each of the boxes, outline your story so that you know exactly what you want to include on that page prior to beginning to draft it in your graphic novel. *The 11 pages of story content are suggested in the sequence of seven to help guide your novel. The other pages are mandatory for uniformity.
